**What is the congregation, assembly, Ekklesia, the Body of Christ?**

Church, Kirche and kościół are false, unbiblical words that we should not use. But first, what is God's plan, purpose, or economy with humanity? We need to know the foundation we stand on.

## Chapter 1:

### The central divine revelation of the Bible, God's economy.

God created man in His image, like Him, and entrusted him with the dominion (domain, authority) over the earth, the sky, and everything living on it.

God wanted a partner equal to Him. Man was meant to eat from the tree of life — that is, to nourish himself through daily fellowship with God in his spirit, being increasingly filled with the divine nature and life.

Man was to extend God's kingship over the earth as sons and daughters of God.

Man fell. Since then, satan has illegally usurped the earth.

(satan is deliberately written in lowercase out of contempt.)

Jesus the Christ, the promised Messiah, is the Son of God from eternity and **became human** (incarnation). He redeemed humanity from corruption and death through His death and resurrection, purchased them with His blood, and secured atonement, justification, and forgiveness of sins. As the last Adam, Jesus brought an end to fallen humanity on the cross.

The man Jesus the Christ **became the Spirit who gives life** through the resurrection. (1 Cor. 15:45)

God's economy is now **that everything is made new in Christ, in the Messiah, and God is distributed into all believers who are born anew and created by God. (Eph. 1:23) This is the Body of Christ,** the kingdom of God, the bride of the Lamb, the house of God, the many sons of God's family, and the ultimate goal is the complete organic mingling of God with redeemed humanity — depicted as the New Jerusalem — the living city, which is also the bride of the Lamb, an organism consisting of God and the redeemed (not dead matter). The essence of an organism is that it is permeated, filled, and animated by the same life. The New Jerusalem is animated by the river of life flowing from God's throne.

Knowing God and the Messiah Jesus and maintaining a personal, close relationship with them is eternal life. John 17:3.

Today, Jesus Christ is as the Body of Christ on earth, distributed through the Holy Spirit among millions of believers.

In summary, we can say:

**God's economy (purpose, plan for humanity on earth) is this:**

God became man in Jesus Christ, who died on the cross, rose again, became the Spirit who gives life, and in the new creation in Christ fills all things with Himself. From this emerges the Body of Christ, the Ekklesia (congregation), through which the kingdom of the heavens is established on earth. It is the bride of the Lamb, the house and temple of God, built from living stones, the family of the heavenly Father. This is completed in the New Jerusalem for all ages.

Before the incarnation of God's Son Jesus, God was only God. Through the conception of Jesus by the Holy Spirit and through the resurrection, God in Jesus also became man. With Jesus' resurrection, a man was brought into the Godhead. Psalm 2:7, Heb. 1:5; Acts 13:32-33, Rom. 1:4.

Through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, Christ as the life-giving compound all inclusive Spirit came into all believers, and thus God's dominion spreads through the Body of Christ on earth.

Even more briefly: God became man, this man became in resurrection the Spirit of life. This Spirit fills the believers so that man, through the Spirit in Christ, is brought into God. The mingling of God with the redeemed New Man in Christ. The enlargement of God in Christ into humanity and the multiplication of God's Son as the many sons and daughters.

The Body of Christ.

This must be proclaimed and demonstrated to all nations as a testimony and proof, through the Body of Christ, and all enemies must be brought under the feet of Jesus, through the congregation, through the Holy Spirit in the believers. The Spirit is the reality of the Body of Christ.

I repeat this so often because it is crucial to understanding the purpose, nature, and role of the congregation.

**The result of God's plan for the world is  
to bring forth the Body of Christ,  
the executive assembly, which, filled with God,  
establishes and executes God's kingdom and will on earth.  
God's principle is to do everything on earth through the Body of Christ.  
The Body of Christ is the body of Jesus on earth,  
the embodiment of God. Everything is made new in Christ.  
Outside of Christ, everything is void and comes to an end.**

## Chapter 2:

### What is the congregation, assembly, Ekklesia — the Body of Christ?

**Beware:** as soon as people receive a revelation about what the Body of Christ is and what they are as a member of the Body of Christ, the heavens are opened, satan is defeated, all evil works are destroyed, and God's dominion is established here and now. That's why satan's strategy is to dilute the understanding of what the congregation (Ekklesia) essentially and practically is.

We no longer have years or decades to enter the reality of the Body of Christ. **That's why I'm getting straight to the practical aspects of the Body of Christ as a local assembly, Ekklesia, congregation.**

The Body of Christ is, on one hand, globally one; on the other hand, practical, concrete congregations form locally, scattered about.

*1 Cor. 12:13: For by One Spirit we were all baptized into One Body, ... and were all made to drink of One Spirit.*

Without rebirth through the Spirit, one is not in the Body. Because we drink of one Spirit, we become the true Body of Christ, *Eph. 5:30: "For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones."*

**Ekklesia = assembly, called-out congregation.**

#### **Wrong word choice leads astray.**

Church, Kirche and kościół are false, unbiblical words that we should not use. It's important to break ourselves of these wrong terms so we can come into the right understanding.

Kościół (Polish) is masculine and reminds one of bones and huge Catholic monster buildings—this has nothing to do with Ekklesia.

Church and Kirche come from kyriakon (krk), house of the Lord. The word isn't negative, but it never appears in the New Testament. Luther correctly translated the Greek Ekklesia as Gemeinde, not Kirche.

Ekklesia means assembly, those called out to an assembly. It was also used in the time of the early congregation for politically important city assemblies. (Acts 19:39)

The Aramaic word Jesus used is **Edta**, which means assembly and is composed of "to gather" and "to come," so:

Come and gather in the presence of God.

**It is an invitation into the presence of God.**

**The congregation (Ekklesia) is  
the assembly of believers  
in the presence of God.**

Prayer: Lord Jesus, I choose Your plan and want to meet from now on with those who come together in this awareness: that we are now concretely entering Your presence so that You may speak to us, enlighten us, and give us commands, decisions, and instructions, and so that we may worship You in Spirit and truth, praise You, and thank You, without hypocrisy or dead rituals.

I no longer want to be distracted or confused by assemblies where Your presence isn't truly the priority.

Give me a clear vision and revelation of the true nature of the congregation. Grant me clear understanding of the great responsibility You've placed on us as members of Your Body to represent You in reality and to do in Your place what You want to do through us. Cleanse me from religious and Babylonian delusions. I commit to painting the true picture of the congregation on my heart.

I want to be a vital member in the reality of Your Body and fulfill my function and destiny. Help me to enter into this fully. Amen.

You have the responsibility to shape your heart from now on with images of this truth: that you recognize your responsibility as a genuine member of the Body of Christ to do exactly what God in Christ wants to do through you. Your responsibility is to figure this out every day and more and more, and not simply waste your life on selfish goals. Even religious activity or a focus on career and profession can prevent God from doing through you what He wants. Read this book at least 3-5 times and meditate on the many quoted words of God.

God's will is so often not done on earth because we do not live as members of the Body of Christ!
