Jesus or if they compromise. Satan can attack them too. You must break with all conscious sins and not presume you can fight alone, unless you are very clearly and specifically led. Pray for protection and preservation and for the revelation of truth for your people.

The plumb line symbolizes the vertically straight line of God for humanity and the earth. God’s chain of command. You have no say in it. If you are stuck in addictions and sins, you are unfit for spiritual warfare and disrupt the necessary harmony of an assembly of the Ekklesia. First, buy the 3x21 day training for a life in the spirit and the book “The Heart” by Reinhard Hirtler to cleanse your heart of impure addictions and thoughts.

What is the congregation, assembly, Ekklesia, the Body of Christ?

Church, Kirche and kościół are false, unbiblical words that we should not use. But first, what is God's plan, purpose, or economy with humanity? We need to know the foundation we stand on.

Chapter 4:

The Checklist: True Ekklesia or Religious Congregation?

What are you when you come together?

Test your self-understanding as an assembly!

This list will help you avoid falling into dead forms or humanly religious organization. You know why you come together and can hardly wait!

△ If the leaders of your group have problems with the following points, then this should be a warning sign about whether it's truly a congregation or just human religious efforts and activities. Paul explicitly warns that everyone should examine themselves before breaking bread, especially regarding whether and how you discern the Body of Christ—that is, how you relate to the Body of Christ, what understanding you have, and what inner heart attitude you hold. 1 Corinthians 11:28-32.

Caution: The powers of darkness will try to prevent you from immediately putting this into practice with 2 or 3 believers. Don't let anything stop you!

- **The Ekklesia, the congregation, is the assembly around God's presence—not around a message or a sermon!!**
- We assemble for worship, praise, thanksgiving, and prayer.
- **The congregation is a command center** to receive orders from the Holy Spirit, to declare God's will, to carry it out, and to execute it. These can be decrees or proclamations for situations and people, or actions in obedience to the Holy Spirit. (See the point on prayer according to 1 Timothy 2.)
- As long as we haven't received specific orders, it's vital to pray in tongues, speaking in tongues. The interpretation of tongues and the gift of prophecy are also crucial for carrying out God's administration. These are what you should eagerly pursue.
- If you as a group or congregation think you can do without the gifts of the Spirit like speaking in tongues, don't be surprised if you mostly remain silent. **Speaking in tongues immediately hands the Holy Spirit the floor to speak, not people.**
- **The Holy Spirit has control, not a human.** Where the Spirit is, there is freedom. The "leaders" must learn not to displace or replace the Holy Spirit.
- **Everyone should function**, not just a few. When praying simultaneously, all may pray in tongues at the same time, and it doesn't need to be translated. This is not the same as when one steps forward and speaks in tongues for everyone. That's only useful if it's interpreted. As already written, words of prophecy, prophesying, and speaking in tongues with satan's greatest nightmare: Ekklesia, the executive assembly of King Jesus, jesus4you.ch S. 18 / 60

interpretation are helpful, as are short words of wisdom. But keep it as brief as possible, and whoever steps forward to speak may be interrupted by others as soon as they sense it's no longer in the Spirit of faith but in human effort. Whoever also wants to contribute their gift—like speaking in tongues, prophesying, or interpreting—**should make it known so that the one speaking hurries to give space to the next.** We can also **pray-read** short sections of the Word together, aware that Jesus is present and gives us understanding of the Bible and strength to obey in love.

- Whoever has a pronounced **gift for teaching** should organize separate assemblies specifically for that purpose, not during the main executive assemblies in the presence of Jesus. Otherwise, it's like someone explaining the Bible while Jesus, who is present, sits unnoticed in the corner. See also the remarks further below about “they continued steadfastly in the apostles' teaching.”
- **Breaking bread** and taking wine to remember Jesus' death and that we are in a covenant through His blood, covenant partners, and form one Body through the Spirit, all depending on each other to remain faithful to Jesus, obey, and fulfill their tasks. Your disobedience affects the whole Body, which is why we should examine ourselves so that we don't eat unworthily and disregard the covenant. Failing to discern the Body in this way is a reason for illnesses and unlawful premature death. (See Jude, Ananias, and Sapphira.)
- **Personal prayer requests:** Keep the group(s) small enough so that personal needs and concerns can be shared and recognized.
- **Prayer according to 1 Timothy 2** for those in authority and for a life in freedom and peace. (Bible text at the end of this section.) Here, God's will is very clearly described, so we can and should always pray for this. This means we must forbid corrupt agendas, and individuals in government, politics, legislatures (Senate, Bundestag, National Council), judiciary (judges, prosecutors), police, military, media, intelligence agencies, and large corporations must be forbidden and replaced if they do not promote the truth—that all may be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth, enabling us to live a peaceful life. Freemasonry and intelligence agencies must be banned.

The demonic powers behind these people with public influence or authority must be bound and stopped.

Significantly, Putin calls Western governments the “empire of lies,” and he's right about that. As the Body of Christ in Europe, the USA, and globally, we must no longer tolerate this—not in our city, district, or country. We discern (expose) the powers and authorities in the heavenly realms (Ephesians 3:10, according to the Aramaic original text). We bind and loose, meaning we forbid evil agendas, depose corrupt criminals in governments and NGOs, and release the word of truth. (NGOs:

Non-Governmental Organizations, e.g., WEF, WHO, UN, IMF.) Such NGOs are heads or horns of the monstrous beast in Revelation, demonized by the antichristian dragon.

Governments should enable a peaceful life in the fear of God and favor the spread of truth. This is the statement of 1 Timothy 2. **They must not themselves become the epitome of tyranny and evil, nor lackeys of greedy oligarchs and satanists.**

The name of God, our Heavenly Father and King of the world (1 Timothy 1:17), is dragged into disgrace by corrupt “authorities” and governments. Governments (authorities) were established by God **to restrain (punish) evil and reward good.**

- **The first Christians at times held everything in common, selling what was superfluous to meet the needs of others—meaning we help each other practically, including materially and financially, and we assist the poor outside as well. This is an important point. We discuss how and which poor, orphans, widows, single parents, homeless, foreigners, sick, and prisoners we can help. We ensure that everyone among us gets by well and doesn’t face existential hardship. We also directly support Christians in poorer countries financially.** Everyone should actively pitch in. Laziness isn’t rewarded but admonished. Someone can voluntarily clean, tidy up, or otherwise make themselves useful if they’re jobless or on welfare. Those who serve intensely in the Word can be financially supported if the benefit is obvious or if the Holy Spirit prompts it. **Importantly, no one should be pressured to give. It should come from joy and love for God and His kingdom.**
- We must be faithful in small things, developing a culture of joyful giving with material goods and money **so that God can entrust us with supernatural finances. As a local command center, we should also become distribution hubs for aid supplies and food.** Food shortages and famines are looming due to the destructive, nonsensical green “Great Reset” agenda, which deliberately ruins food production and critical industries—this is terrorism, yet they (still) sit in governments. Therefore, as an assembly, we must build and manage food reserves for distribution (not just for ourselves), ideally produce some ourselves, and, on the other hand, forbid this agenda of destroying food production through prayer and decrees.
- **We pray for the sick**—Jesus commands: Heal the sick, raise the dead, cast out demons. This isn’t optional; it’s a crucial part of preaching the gospel. We go as aggressively against sickness, death, and demons as Jesus, Curry Blake, David Hogan, Mark Hemans, J.G. Lake, Smith Wigglesworth, or Lester Sumrall did. Jesus healed everyone brought to Him. Premature death and sickness are illegal in the kingdom of God. **Healing is part of the redemption work. By His stripes, we are**

healed. Therefore, we can directly issue corresponding commands for healing and deliverance from demons when we meet or encounter the sick. Jesus does the healing, but we must speak it, command it, and force obedience under Jesus. For this, we must choose to believe and obey.

- **And they continued steadfastly in prayer,** breaking bread, and the **apostles' teaching.** Acts 2:42. **The apostles' teaching is the New Testament**—especially the briefly summarized economy of God above as the central revelation of God's plan in the Bible. Instead of having to listen to local self-important people for hours, who think they need to dig everything out of the Bible anew themselves and emphasize unimportant things, we can today, thanks to the internet, YouTube, and books, directly hear and read the **best Bible teachers like Kevin Zadai, Watchman Nee, Witness Lee, Andrew Wommack, Myles Munroe, Derek Prince, Dutch Sheets, Curry Blake, Reinhard Hirtler, Mark Hemans, Dave Roberson, Rick Renner, and John Bevere.** Local teachers should always be well-acquainted with at least some of the above-mentioned Bible teachers; otherwise, there's a risk they'll teach something non-central. Local self-important types, those with ambition or pride, can quickly displace the Holy Spirit and lord it over others. The others must stop them, and if that's not possible, form a new group. Everyone should personally check things in the Word. We no longer have time for such nonsense.

We recommend to everyone, especially newcomers, to listen to at least 2-3 messages weekly from the teachers listed above and read their books so they can be saturated with healthy teaching and doctrine as quickly as possible. This keeps them from being tossed back and forth by every wind of doctrine or led astray from the truth of the gospel's freedom by unimportant teachings, false teachings, or heresies. Of course, they should also read the Bible directly every day. We're aware there are many other pretty good teachers, "apostles," prophets, and preachers out there. But we regard the ones mentioned here as the most important teachers for central, healthy doctrine. Others may be good in specific areas. We're not saying you can't listen to or read others too. But we have no more time to waste and want to focus on the central revelation in power and authority. Jesus is coming for an adorned, blameless, mature bride without the stench of Babylon.

Ruling through Prayer,

as Derek Prince says about this passage:

***) 1 Timothy 2:**

1 First of all, then, I urge that requests, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people,

2 for kings and all who are in high positions, so that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life in all godliness and dignity;

3 for this is good and pleasing before God our Savior,

4 who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of truth.

5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,

6 who gave Himself as a ransom for all—the testimony given at the proper time,

7 for which I was appointed a preacher and apostle—I speak the truth in Christ and do not lie—a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

8 Therefore, I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands without anger or doubt.

9 Likewise, [I want] women to adorn themselves with respectable decency, with modesty and self-control, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing,

10 but with good works, as is fitting for women who profess godliness.

Romans 13 makes it unmistakably clear **that authorities (governments) exist to punish evil and reward good. However, most governments today have virtually become the embodiment of evil itself.** This drags our Heavenly Father Name through the mud, since He established authorities to curb evil. It's not the Father's will that such degenerate, corrupt, murderous, terrorist, fascist governments exist. This is also hinted at in Revelation, where only the beast, animated by the dragon, is mentioned—not governments anymore. This beast fights the saints and blasphemes God. This beast (world governments) and the lying media (false prophet) are thrown into the lake of fire in Revelation 19, through our word and Jesus' word.

⚠ Such criminal, corrupt governments and corporations are kakourgocracies (rule by criminals) and **could only arise because most Christians were asleep and not living in the reality of the Body of Christ—meaning the Body wasn't formed, built up, or mature, and didn't issue commands.**

That's the purpose of this book: to bring the glorious congregation to full function in supreme authority, as warriors and lovers of Christ, a adorned bride in the unity of knowledge and maturity.

What still restrains the revealing of the man of lawlessness (often called **the Antichrist**), we know, writes Paul in 2 Thessalonians. Most interpreters say he means the Holy Spirit in us. I agree, but we must also speak it out.

The authority of the Holy Spirit must be demonstrated through us.

Once again: What are we as a local congregation?

- An embassy of the kingdom of God in our city.
- Command center of the kingdom of heaven in our city, country.
- City council, council assembly. Ruling assembly of a city.
- The local portal to heaven, the local government of heaven.
- A congregation.
- Executive assembly, committee.
- Committee for executing decisions.
- God's headquarters in our city.
- A team of liberation agents of the ruling assembly of King Jesus in our city.

Daniel 4:14 shows an example of how the saints, by decree, depose a tyrannical world ruler (temporarily). Because he repented, he regained power:

*14 This was decided in the council of the watchers, **discussed and demanded by the saints**, so that the living may recognize that the Most High rules over the kingdom of men and gives it to whom He wills, even setting the lowliest of men over it!*

Practical Task:

Find at least one person—either in person or by phone—with whom you can pray God’s will in His presence for at least 10 minutes. Do this daily or several times a week, at least once weekly.

If you can’t find anyone, join the group t.me/Kingdom_Exchange; maybe you’ll find someone there.

Otherwise, do it alone: set a daily assembly time and take on the role of a second person in your imagination (like a comedian playing multiple roles). Bring your spirit, soul, heart, and body into the meeting, and invite Jesus too. You can start by saying in your mind: “You, soul, mind, will, emotions, heart, spirit, and body, we now assemble as Ekklesia in the name of Jesus.”

See yourself in His presence and pray in tongues for at least 10 minutes.

Read this checklist multiple times. Read the Bible verses prayerfully. Meditate in prayer and thanksgiving over every point.

Consider whom you can practically help.

Discover your task. God has a plan and a purpose for you right where you are.

Start casting out demons, commanding everything you encounter daily that opposes the knowledge of God into obedience to Christ.

To stand in the end times as the beast increasingly takes shape, it’s absolutely vital that the Body of Christ finally forms as the glorious executive assembly and congregation and carries out its eternal mission according to God’s plan.
