

Direct Connection to God



**The Messiah Jesus is the Way
to the Father in Heaven.**

Through the blood of Jesus you have instant and constant direct access to the throne of God, to the Father in Heaven!

This means you can come with everything, every problem, every worry at any time and immediately to the throne of grace, into God's presence, cleansed from a guilty conscience by the blood of Jesus.

Remain in Christ, in the Messiah, in Jesus – then you will experience this reality.

How can you remain in the Lord Jesus?

Very simply: Do not trust in your own righteousness or goodness. Deny your self and your soul life by consciously submitting to the Holy Spirit and believing like a child. **In your heart you are convinced of the fact that through the blood of Jesus you can now and at any time come into the presence and fellowship of God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit – and remain there – far above all earthly, natural, soulish, physical and material problems, troubles or desires.**

When Jesus died on the cross, the veil to the Holy of Holies in the temple was torn.

Through the resurrection of Jesus from the dead on the third day, God begot you anew in the Messiah (Christ).

When you come to faith in Jesus and believe this with your heart and turn to God the Father, **you are born again of God, and the seed of the divine life comes into your spirit. You are now in Christ (in the Messiah) a new, divine person.**

You are now a genuine child of God, born again of God, and you have direct access to God the Father and the Son. The Holy Spirit and with Him the Father and the Son makes His home in you.

(John 14).

It is your responsibility to let this truth grow and flourish in your heart until your heart is fully convinced of it. You live and experience what your heart is convinced of.

The New Testament knows no box.

Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. There are no more stone temples, and no priests between you and God. You are now a priest to God, just like all other believers.

The clergy system sabotages what the gospel of Jesus has brought to all people.

Many Christians make the fatal mistake – through religion – and tradition of packaging this central truth of the gospel into a box called “church” or whatever the Christian “denominations” may call themselves. If you identify with such a church or denomination, you create for yourself a separation that Jesus tore down on the cross.

The assembly (council) of Jesus as His body on earth is not a human organization or church, but the gathering of believers who are aware that they have been born of God and live in direct connection with the Father. **They come together into the presence of God to communicate directly with**

God, to function as a divine council on earth in their location – **to call forth the will of God** – and to help, support and inspire one another.

Squandering the Potential

The Christ (Messiah), the Anointed One, is in us as the Holy Spirit, the anointing.

If someone gave you a winning certificate for 10 million in the evening, you would hardly sleep. You would imagine how you would redeem the winnings the next morning and make many pictures in your heart with your imagination about everything you could and surely would do with the money.

But imagine: it is not a mere 10 million dollars you have received,

but the Creator of the universe has come into you as the Holy Spirit!

Christ in us, the hope (imagination) of glory.
(Colossians 1:27)

How can you sleep peacefully in view of this greatest of all conceivable gifts?

We should inwardly be excited day and night and vividly imagine – with a burning heart of love for Jesus – everything we will do with God who is in us. We should discuss our life in hot conversations with the King, the Father and the Son, and take possession of our royal inheritance. We should imagine how we now live with glory and royal heavenly splendor and adjust our lives to this royal heavenly standard.

It is a great tragedy how most people and Christians so carelessly squander this extreme potential. They chase after earthly pleasures and care little or nothing that they can be infinitely close to God and remain in this closeness.

There must be a huge difference between a life in God, with Christ dwelling in you, and a life without the Holy Spirit.

You no longer have any excuse to remain in or indulge any addiction, because in one single moment of the heart – washed in the blood of Jesus – you are in the presence of the Heavenly Father and of Jesus.

It comes down to what you want to love more from now on: God, or the short-term earthly, fleshly, worldly pleasure of the senses and of the proud soul life. Will you indulge the lust of the eyes or the love for the Father? (1 John 2:15-17).

If you choose God in this holy, decisive moment — good.

Prepare yourself and be ready, **because your old heart, which loved sin and was full of sinful habits and thoughts, will try to sabotage you from putting God first on the throne.** Continually repent. Recognize and know that this old person was crucified and died with Christ.

If you are in Christ and remain in Him, and He in you, this is reality. In your spirit the divine, sinless, glorious life is growing. You are becoming a king and priest.

In this transition phase you must reprogram your new heart with divine truth, with the Word of God, the Bible, lay aside the old person with his habits, and put on the new person who is like Jesus.

Reprogram your heart: For everything in your life – everything you have, do, or encounter – imagine live and vividly how you now live and do it with the glory and dignity of a child of the King. Be proud of your Father in Heaven – He is the King of the world. Discuss everything with Him. Meditate day and night on this truth.

If something is hard for you to believe because it simply sounds too glorious, too good to be true, then speak and pray in tongues for days on end until it becomes clear to you, until you know it is God's will, and until it manifests in your life.

What your heart is convinced of – that is what you live and experience.
